Soroptimist History



DID YOU KNOW?

Do you know why the headquarters of Soroptimist International is located in England?

In the late 1960's, there were three federations: Soroptimist International of the Americas, Soroptimist International of Europe and Soroptimist International of Great Britain & Ireland. Each federation was asked to submit one city for consideration as "the" Soroptimist International headquarters. Those choices

were then sent back to each federation to vote for their city by preference as #1, #2, or #3. The European and Great Britain & Ireland federations voted for each of their cities as #1 and #2, while voting for the Americas federation city as #3. Soroptimist International of the Americas voted for their city (New York) as #1 and London as #2, so London came out as the top city.

From 1969—1976, there were various locations in London for the Soroptimist International offices. By 1976, it was determined that London was too expensive, and space was rented in Cambridge until 1986, when the final home for Soroptimist International headquarters was purchased
